TIPS TO TEACHING PARENTS:

One of the first things any teacher must learn is not to do all the talking. This is equally true for the professor teaching physics or for the parent teaching godliness. Men learn by asking questions and by stating truths in their own words. To do the best job of teaching our children, we must encourage them to talk out and participate verbally in study sessions.

How can you stimulate this kind of discussion in home studies? Take this week's lesson for an example. You might ask one of your children, "Why did Moses hide the body?" "What was wrong with his attempt to hide his crime?" or "What might Moses have done besides hiding the truth?"

One way to get quiet, shy children to participate is to have them read from the Bible. Ask one of your children to read some verse in the story as you are telling it. Or have various members of the family read the Scriptures that teach the truth of the story. Every week you can find a number of verse that fit. (The section below "FOR ADULT STUDY" can help you with this.)

Read the gospel of John and see Jesus' teaching technique. He always made his hearers participate. And He was the Master Teacher.
